As per the request of the Government of Tamil Nadu vide letter dated 03-07-2020, all jute mills are directed to dispatch the unsupplied quantity of jute bags (scheduled to be despatched by Rail) against PCSO dated **04-03-2020** to the destinations as per priority as indicated below:-

Priority 1.	Thanjavur (Kumbakonam)	10,480
Priority 2.	Nagapattinam	7,000
Priority 3.	Thiruvarur	1,500

West Bengal based jute mills are directed to dispatch their unsupplied quantity to any of these three destinations/railheads as per priority as mentioned above, irrespective of the destinations stated in their PCSOs. No further manual amendments shall be needed as long as the inspected stocks are sent to any of the three destinations/railheads tabulated above. Mills are also requested to send all original relevant documents to the consignees corresponding to the respective destinations.
