This is in reference to the meeting held on 31-10-2025 at Patsan Bhawan, Kolkata regarding the registration of jute mills on the upgraded "JUTE-SMART 2.0" portal.

- 2. In this regard it is informed that the Jute SMART 2.0 portal has been made live on (https://smart.jutecomm.gov.in). It is requested to register your jute mill on the portal. It is further informed that the user to be registered on portal must be any director/partner/proprietor of the company/partnership/proprietorship depending on your mill's organization. The following steps are required for registration:
 - Fill the web form on https://smart.jutecomm.gov.in/mill-registration-form/new completing the details. It is reiterated that the registering user shall be director/partner/proprietor of the company/partnership/proprietorship. The registration details shall be the e-mail id of the registering user and the password set by them.
 - ii) User shall login with username and password on the https://smart.jutecomm.gov.in and complete the Jute Mill Registration form.
 - iii) The form shall be submitted after e-sign of the registering user.

Once the registration form is submitted by your jute mill, the installed capacity of the mill shall be configured by o/o Jute Commissioner in the Jute SMART system. After approval of the registration of your jute mill, you are required to submit your Commitment to Supply details after logging into the portal. It may be noted that the allocation ratios for December 2025 onwards shall be calculated automatically using the details submitted by you on the portal by taking into account the installed capacity assessed by o/o Jute Commissioner and the commitment to supply submitted by your mill. Therefore, if you do not submit the commitment to supply on the portal after completion of registration;

your allocation ratio shall be taken as zero because the system calculates the allocation ratio automatically without manual intervention and no communication shall be entertained in this regard.
