ORDER

Reference is invited on the representations of industry association for 100% bill amount to be released as a short-term measure. Ministry of Textiles has conveyed the approval of Competent Authority for release of 95% of amount to the Jute Mills as a short-term measure until **31st December 2024**, as against the current practice of 90% release on proof of dispatch.

The necessary changes have been effected in Jute SMART for **bills being generated w.e.f. 04.12.2024**. Further, the jute mills are additionally required to submit an undertaking (given in the Annexure-I) to make up any loss to any organization due to poor quality of their supply.

The same would be without prejudice to any other action which Jute Commissioner may initiate against the jute mills company, for any violation under the Jute and Jute Textile Control Order 2016 or any other Order passed by the Jute Commissioner or any other authority of Govt. of India from time to time.

The freight and the other incidental expenses incurred in the dispatch and transportation of the rejected bales will be borne by us both ways.
