Subject: Submission of Commitment for Supply of B. Twill Bags - regarding:

Sir,

In continuation to this office letter no. Jute (Econ.)/Allocation/2016 dated 4th April, 2023 on the subject cited above; all the jute mills are requested to furnish their firm written commitment for supply of B. Twill jute bags in the form of an **UNDERTAKING** for next six (6) months i.e. from October 2024 to March 2025.

A proforma of undertaking for supply of B. Twill jute bags is enclosed with this letter. It is pertinent to mention that the undertaking has to be submitted on a Non-Judicial Stamp paper of ₹20/- to this office positively by 27th September, 2024.

The issuance of monthly Production-Cum-Supply Orders (PCSO) would be in accordance with the allocation policy as decided by the O/o the Jute Commissioner from time to time. **It may be noted that the “Information on payment of statutory dues to jute workers and prompt payment to jute farmers and balers” is required to be submitted by 20th of the following month by the mill, which has been incorporated at point no. 8 of the UNDERTAKING.** The change may be noted by all the mills and compliance of point no.8 be ensured by everyone.

It is to be noted that if any mill(s) fails to submit their commitments by 27/09/2024, it would be presumed that such mill(s) is not willing to supply and thus shall not be considered for PCSO allocation until submission of the commitment.

This issues with the approval of Jute Commissioner.

FORM OF UNDERTAKING TO BE EXECUTED BY JUTE MILLS FOR RECEIVING B-TWILL BAGS PRODUCTION CONTROL-CUM-SUPPLY ORDERS FROM JUTE COMMISSIONER:

Our mill having considered the offer made by the Jute Commissioner vide his letter No Jute (Econ)/Allocation/2016, Dated on the issue of supply of B-Twill bags for the period October, 2024 to March, 2025 and undertake as follows:

- (i) The mill supply B-Twill bags conforming to BIS standard IS 16186:2014 to government agencies as ordered by the Jute Commissioner as per the following schedule:-

Note: Each bale shall consists of 500 B-Twill bags of 580 gm each conforming to IS 16186: 2014.

- (ii) The B-Twill bags will be supplied against Production Control-Cum-Supply Order (PCSO) subject to the total quantity committed in each month as at serial (i) above or the maximum capacity of the mill/unit (as recognized by the Jute Commissioner) whichever is lower, at price to be declared by the Jute Commissioner.
- (iii) We shall not, in the course of the year, be entitled to modify the quantities committed as above.
- (iv) The terms and conditions of supply shall be guided by the PCSOs. Terms and Conditions of supply may change during the year. The monthly allocation to the jute mills shall be as per the policy to be decided by the Jute Commissioner.

We also understand the following:

- 1) The commitment of the mill to supply B-Twill bags will not automatically entitle us to receive Production Control-cum-Supply Order. The quantity specified in the Production Control-cum-Supply Order will also depend upon the overall requirement of jute bags by government agencies.
- 2) In case the commitment made is larger than the capacity of the mill as assessed by the Jute Commissioner, the Jute Commissioner shall be entitled to limit the order to within the assessed capacity.

- 3) The minimum commitment to supply in any month shall not be less by more than 20% of the maximum commitment during the period. (e.g. If a mill commits a maximum capacity of 7000 bales in any month during the period, its minimum commitment during the period shall not be less than $7000 - 1400 = 5600$ bales). If such a variation is detected, the Jute Commissioner shall be free to adjust the quantities accordingly.
- 4) The Jute Commissioner will endeavor to issue PCSO within the 6th of any calendar month subject to indents being received by the 4th of that month and the mill will be required to offer this quantity for inspection before the end of the month.
- 5) In case of failure of the mill to supply B-Twill bags as per the Production Control-cum-Supply Orders issued in accordance with this policy, the Jute Commissioner shall be entitled to take such penal measures against the mill as per provisions contained in the Jute and Jute Textiles Control Order, 2016.
- 6) In the event of failure to intimate the Jute Commissioner about closure / suspension of work / strike within twenty four hours from the incident, Production Control-cum-Supply Orders (PCSO) shall not be issued for the next six months from the date of reopening of the mill/withdrawal of suspension of work or strike.
- 7) If a mill is found to have indulged in unfair practices like supply of used bags, under weight bags, poor quality bags and bags illegally imported, action will be initiated as per clause 8 of the Jute and Jute Textiles Control Order, 2016.
- 8) Submission of the following returns by jute mills will be monitored by the office of the Jute Commissioner every month/year. If a mill fails to submit any return as per the time schedule mentioned below, appropriate measures including denial of Production Control-cum-Supply Order or blacklisting of the said mill will be initiated.
