ORDER

Reference is invited to the representation of Indian Jute Mills Association (IJMA) vide Letter No. IJMA/02052020/Pricing/K-46(T.C.)/1148-D/02 dated 02.05.2020. On receipt of approval of the Ministry of Textiles with the concurrence of IFW vide letter dated 17th June 2020 this office notifies the following:

“Due to extra ordinary situation created by COVID-19, release of Payment of 100% amount to Jute Mills is hereby allowed *for a maximum period of 3 months with a review after each month*. In this regard the Jute Mills are required to submit an Undertaking (given in the annexure) to make up any loss to any recipient organization due to poor quality of their supply . JC Office will remain in constant touch with the consignee for detecting immediate fault in quality. All Jute Mills are hereby informed that the above order should be maintained strictly. This will be effected from 1st July 2020 for a maximum period of 3 months or further orders, whichever is earlier.”

The same would be without prejudice to any other action which Jute Commissioner may initiate against the Jute Mill Company; for any violation under the Jute & Jute Textile Control Order 2016 or any other Order passed by the Jute Commissioner or any other authority of Govt. of India from time to time.

The freight and the other incidental expenses incurred in the dispatch and transportation of the rejected bales will be borne by us both ways.
