Notes:

- * All data for a financial year must be compiled on the basis of RGI register maintained by the jute mill.
- * The electricity consumption (only for the mill) should also be compiled for the calendar year based on energy bills (copies of which must be provided).
- * In case of mills outside West Bengal, the units generated by the mill may be added alongwith supporting documents.
- * If mill has any "Other" product, such products may be dealt with as follows:
 - (a) CBC and other Jute Diversified Products may be added to Hessian production.
 - (b) Soil savers and other geotextiles may be added to sacking production.
 - (c) Sacking Cloth / Sheet to be included in Sacking production / purchase and Hessian Sheet / Bags to be included in Hessian production / purchase.
- * Period of strikes/lockouts/Suspension of work should be supported by documents.
- * New units starting commercial production after 01/01/18 may intimate their start up date along with supporting documents.
- * This office shall carry out sample checks on data. Care should be taken to fill up the data. Errors would be viewed seriously.
- * The statement should be signed by President/CEO of the mill or a Director authorised to do so.

Sir,

The existing allocation policy of PCSO quota considers data of calendar years 2015, 2016 and 2017. The parameters that had been considered include installed capacity at the mills, actual production in the preceding years and cost of goods sold in the preceding years. As you would agree these have undergone substantial changes in the last five years. Also with subsequent policy introduction by the Department of Food and Public Distribution, the demand-supply scenario has completely changed.

Under the circumstances, it is requested that the allocation policy may kindly be updated with mill-wise data of the years 2018, 2019 and 2020. This would be representative of the existing scenario at the jute mills.
