
**NOTICE**

It is informed by the States of Punjab and Haryana that procurement operations of foodgrains have already started there and is likely to be completed by April 2025. For packing of foodgrains in jute bags, the State Procurement Agencies (SPAs) of these states require the entire ordered quantity immediately so that there are no disruptions in the procurement operations.

In view of above, all jute mills are directed to ensure supply of the allotted quantity of jute bags on account of Punjab and Haryana within 30<sup>th</sup> April 2025. It is further informed that no extension of delivery period would be granted beyond 30<sup>th</sup> April 2025 for PCSOs meant for Punjab and Haryana.

It is reiterated that non-supply or default in supply of jute bags are considered as “unfair practices”. Jute Commissioner may initiate the proceedings for default in supply of jute bags under the relevant provisions of Jute and Jute Textiles Control Order, 2016 in case of non-supply of the required quantity within the defined delivery period.
