Sub: Penalty and Incentive for Supply Performance of the Jute Mills-reg.

Sir,

This is with reference to this office letter of even number dated 07-08-2025 on the above-mentioned subject.

It has been observed that with respect to clause (iii) of the Policy, a number of mills have PCSOs pending for inspection which are 60 days or older. Further, difficulties have been expressed regarding immediate compliance with change in policy. Therefore, one time relaxation is provided from the clause till 31<sup>st</sup> August 2025. These mills shall be considered for allocation provided their backlog supply ratio is less than 1.25 or 1.25 times the benchmark backlog ratio, whichever is higher.

The mills having backlog pertaining to PCSOs issued in June 2025 or earlier are directed to get them inspected immediately. From 1<sup>st</sup> September 2025, the mills having backlog for the PCSOs issued before 60 days shall not be considered for allocation irrespective of their backlog supply ratio in terms of policy dated 7<sup>th</sup> August 2025. It is reiterated that no relaxation shall henceforth be provided from the policy dated 7<sup>th</sup> August 2025.
