**Sub: Speedy dispatch of gunny bags of PUNGRAIN.**

Sir,

It has been reported by Govt. of Punjab (PUNGRAIN) vide letter dated 25-09-2019 that jute mills are offering less quantity of jute bales for inspection for dispatch through railways. As a result of insufficient quantity of jute bags, railway rake could not be formed for dispatches of jute bags to the indenting agency (PUNGRAIN).

You are aware that the procurement operation of foodgrains will start from 01-10-2019. In order to ensure dispatch of the entire indented quantity, all jute mills should come forward to offer inspected bales scheduled to be despatched by rail as maximum quantity as possible so that rakes can be formed quickly.

All concerned Jute mills are directed to offer bales due to be moved by rail expeditiously so that the entire ordered quantity for rail movement is completed at the earliest.
