Sub: Supply of B-Twill jute bags to Govt. of Uttar Pradesh against PCSO dated **01-05-2019** scheduled to be despatched by Rail.

Sir,

As per the request of the Govt. of Uttar Pradesh vide letter dated 30-04-2019, all loaders have been directed to dispatch the quantity of jute bags against PCSOs dated 01-05-2019 to the destinations/railheads with scheduled quantity strictly, as per priority, as indicated below:-

Mills are also requested to send original RRs and other relevant documents to the consignees corresponding to the respective destinations.
