Sub: Supply of B-Twill jute bags for Kharif:2020-21.

Sir,

It has been observed that as on date the total outstanding quantity in supply of jute bags is 5.52 lakh bales. Out of this, 3.17 lakh bales are against PCSOs issued from June to Sept, 2020 and 2.35 lakh bales are against PCSOs issued in the month of October, 2020.

With a view to ensure balance in supply of jute bags of all the PCSOs issued for the Kharif:2020-21 season, jute mills are directed to plan before offering goods for inspection in such a way as to ensure that total inspected quantity in this month (Oct'20) covers at least 60% of the backlog quantity from PCSOs issued from June'20 to September, 2020 and remaining percentage quantity from PCSOs issued in the month of October, 2020. The position will be reviewed at the end of this month and any failure in maintaining the ratio will be dealt with strictly as per procedure.

A copy of this letter is being forwarded to all Inspection Agencies to ensure that mills are complying with the above decision.
