The existing allocation policy of PCSO quota considers data of calendar years 2015, 2016 and 2017. The parameters that had been considered include installed capacity at the mills, actual production in the preceding years and cost of goods sold in the preceding years. As you would agree these have undergone substantial changes in the last five years. Also with subsequent policy introduction by the Department of Food and Public Distribution, the demand-supply scenario has completely changed.

Under the circumstances, it is requested that the allocation policy may kindly be updated with mill-wise data of the years 2018,2019 and 2020. This would be representative of the existing scenario at the jute mills.
