Sub: Supply of B-Twill jute bags to Bihar against PCSO dated 01-02-2018.

Sir,

This has reference to this office letter of even number dated 26-02-2018 on the above subject. It has been ascertained that presently the Rail head Narayanpur Anant is inoperative. This office has taken up the matter with Govt. of Bihar when they have confirmed vide letter dated 19-03-2018 that the planned quantity meant for Narayanpur Anant may be sent to Sasaram. As per the confirmation of the Govt. of Bihar, this office has directed all loaders to dispatch the indented quantity of jute bags to the destinations as per priority indicated below:-
