**Sub:** Supply of B-Twill jute bags to Madhya Pradesh against PCSO issued during 10-11-2017 to 20-04-2018 scheduled to be despatched by Rail.

Sir,

In supersession of this office letter of even number dated 25-04-2018 and as per the request of the Govt. of Madhya Pradesh vide letter dated 27-04-2018, all jute mills are directed to dispatch the unsupplied quantity against PCSO issued during 10-11-2017 to 20-04-2018 (scheduled to be despatched by Rail only) to the destinations as indicated below:-

Priority Sl. No.	Destinations	No. of Bales	Allocated Loading Point
1	SATNA	5200	TITAGARH
2	VIKRAMNAGAR	5200	BHADRESHWAR
3	KACHHPURA	5200	BALLY

West Bengal based jute mills are directed to dispatch their inspected stores through any of these three loading points as mentioned above, irrespective of the destinations stated in their PCSOs. However, in no case, the total quantity against each destination shall exceed 5,200 bales. No further manual amendments shall be needed as long as the inspected stocks are sent to any of the three (3) destinations tabulated above. Mills are also requested to send original RRs and other relevant documents to the consignees corresponding to the destinations.
