Sub: Poor offering of bales by jute mills to CONCOR.

Sir,

1. It has been brought to our notice by CONCOR that jute mills are not offering bales to them proportionate to the allotted quantity. The agency/indenter wise quantity allocated to different mills, quantity inspected & passed and backlog quantity are given below:-

2. It appears from the above table that around 83,904 bales are yet to be inspected and passed by jute mills. Due to low offering of bales by jute mills, the infrastructural capacity for lifting of goods of CONCOR is remaining idle.

3. All mills are requested to offer bales to CONCOR expeditiously so that the entire capacity of CONCOR is utilized and also the goods are despatched as per requirements of the indenting agencies.
