Sub: Supply of B-Twill jute bags to Govt. of Uttar Pradesh against PCSO dated 10-10-2019 scheduled to be despatched by Rail.

Sir,

As per the request of the Govt. of Uttar Pradesh vide letter dated 25-09-2019, all loaders have been directed to dispatch the quantity of jute bags against PCSOs dated 10-10-2019 to the destinations/railheads with scheduled quantity strictly, as per priority, as indicated below:-

Jute mills are accordingly directed to dispatch their allocated quantity to any of these six destinations/railheads as mentioned above, irrespective of the destinations stated in their PCSOs. No further manual amendments shall be needed as long as the inspected stocks are sent to any of the six (6) destinations/railheads tabulated above. Mills are also requested to send original RRs and other relevant documents to the consignees corresponding to the respective destinations.
