Sub: Submission of copies of RG-1 and Invoices.

Sir,

1. In view of the large volumes of gunnies required for the procurement of foodgrains in the coming Rabi season, utilization of maximum capacity of the jute mills is required for production. In this connection, all jute mills have already been directed vide Order dated 07-02-2017 by the undersigned to utilize their necessary and adequate installed sacking capacity for exclusive manufacture of the specified quantities of B.Twill jute bags of size of 94cm X 57cm as per directions contained in Production Control Orders issued to them for Rabi: 2017-18 and that no part of the aforesaid capacity shall be diverted in any manner for production of sacking other than B.Twill jute bags which is meant for supply on Govt. account.
2. Despite issuing such Order dated 07-02-2017, the pace of supply has not improved to the extent it is required. It is apprehended that the Central Government may consider granting of further relaxation for use of HDPE/PP bags in addition to 5.0 lakh bales already allowed.
3. In order to monitor more closely the supply performance of each jute mills on supply of bags on Government sector and on other sectors, jute mills are directed to submit copies of RG-1 and related invoice in support of despatch on a daily basis beginning from 08-03-2017. For monitoring these documents, a Cell has been constituted in this office headed by Shri Sujit Pal, Director(Cost) [Tel No. 2337-6978]. Mills are, therefore, requested to send all these documents to the Cell in the names of Ms. Rajani Behera, Inspector and Shri Sukumar Sarkar.
