Sub: Supply of B-Twill jute bags to Uttar Pradesh against PCSOs dated 19-02-2018, 20-02-2018 and 24-04-2018.

Sir,
In supersession of this office letter of even number dated 25-04-2018 and as per the request of the Govt. of Uttar Pradesh vide letter dated 27-04-2018, this office has directed all loaders to dispatch the quantity of jute bags against PCSOs dated 19-02-2018, 20-02-2018 and 24-04-2018 to the destinations as per priority as indicated below:-

| 1 | Roza, Sahahjahanpur | 5460 | Bally |
| 2 | Gazipur - Gazipur City Rly. Stn. | 3900 | Kankinara |
| 3 | Orai | 3900 | Naihati |
| 4 | Gorakhpur - Nakaha Jungle, Gorakhpur | 3900 | Bhadreshwar |
| 5 | Sitapur – Thomsonganj Siding, Sitapur | 4400 | Titagarh |
| 6 | Barabanki | 3900 | Bally |

West Bengal based jute mills are directed to dispatch their inspected stores through any of these six loading points serially as mentioned above, irrespective of the destinations stated in their PCSOs. No further manual amendments shall be needed as long as the inspected stocks are sent to any of the six (6) destinations tabulated above. This is being done to speed up dispatches as per the priority provided by the Government of Uttar Pradesh. Mills are also requested to send original RRs to the O/o the Resident Representative, Govt. of U.P., 12A, N.S.Road, Kolkata-1.
